We are submitting this Letter of Intent to assure you of our interest in evaluating and addressing your humanitarian projects for funding.

- 1. \$100M feature film
- 2. \$500K Social Media launch
- 3. \$60K for legal counsel to set up an offshore 'eleemosynary' and onshore B-corp

You have further stated a requirement for \$750K in seed monies to cover expenses for the first eighteen months to:

- a) budget the business plan(s) for the Projects
- b) ensure that they are successfully initiated, produced, managed and implemented--as established self-sustaining programs

As we have offered to help set up an offshore entity to receive funds, some of these costs will be reduced.

We shall consider the merits of setting up an 'eleemosynary' and/or a private-trust established offshore while being linked to a Nevada benefit corporation and/or second trust for tax purposes, to operate within the U.S. as well as in other countries.

We have the following Project requests and estimates on record as follows:

- 1. to hire several professionals to help language the multi-cultural presentation of your 'collective mindfulness' education programs for those engaging in Phoenix Voyage, [\$ 30K] for age-related and cultural language adaptations.
- 2. We understand that additional professionals would serve as consultants to develop the infrastructure for your implementation of a 'cost-free' worldwide 24/7 social-media platform for sharing 'collective mindfulness' online [\$500K].
- 3. Wherein seed monies would cover, Danielle Lanyard's compensation details:
 - a. a 6 month inception plan contract: 1st month \$7,500, after which it will expand to \$18,000 a month, for a one year contract, to include her managing a team of 3 (she would bring in this team) to implement the inception plan. It's likely seed monies would cover some of the initial costs. Also, Justin Law would be providing additional marketing, website development and strategic planning for \$5K.

Francis Della Vecchia, has offered to be budgeted at a low \$100/hr. You both envision a series of short test films [\$100K] to create a "proof of concept" for demonstrating to executive producers, directors and actors how viewing audiences will share a commonly sensed consciousness. Mark Allan Kaplan, Ph. D., Director and Researcher, Integral Cinema Project, will work with you on both treatment and script development [\$52K]. Your "guestament" to complete and distribute this film is [\$100M],

- 5. This film also presents a multi-lab demonstration (underway for over twenty-years) of participants' (humanity's) 'indivisibility' on instrument, when apparently separated by thousands of miles [\$711K]. This amount is included in the \$100M. http://connectioninstitute.org/PDF/Y-THE_HUMAN_CONNECTION_PROJECT.pdf
- 6. Socially acceptable forms of mind-to-mind communication will be showcased in the form of technological (app) assists through co-creative resonance in games [\$100K]. Seed monies could cover these costs. You plan to be working with Dr. Mandy Scott through Dr. Michael Persinger's lab at Laurentian University in Sudbury, Ontario, Canada.
- 7. Research collaborations in physics, including the creation of an international conference on the physics of consciousness at Vetha.org, with presentations and co-authored studies experimentally researching the origins of consciousness including various technological applications [\$100K], covered by seed monies.
- 8. SellaFresh: Ending hunger through innovations in un-refrigerated food [\$22M] preservation, improved food distribution, and rapid healing from most illnesses.
- 9. Accredited university for consciousness-based degrees at Vetha.org [\$25M], designed as a scientific research institute with a trans-disciplinary orientation, integrating user experience with evidence based investigation. An executive summary and also business plan exists which will be supplied when requested.
- 10. Personal nutritional/dental, health related, living and traveling costs [\$30K].

Summary of costs: 750K, 100M, 22M, 25M, 30K = \$147.78M

Our intention is to ensure these projects observe sound sustainable business practices by offering ongoing professional guidance and networked support.

Considerations: We are willing to provide compensation upon consideration of the specifics listed above once we have made a thorough review which will result in a Commitment to fund within the next 30 days or less. Funding is estimated before Christmas.
